BULAN BAHASA 2025: CELEBRATING THE MALAY LANGUAGE THROUGH THE MALAY CULTURAL ARTS



Majlis Bahasa Melayu Singapura (MBMS or Malay Language Council, Singapore) presented the official launch of Bulan Bahasa 2025 via telecast on Mediacorp Suria, at 8.30pm on Friday, 29 August 2025. The programme is now available for on-demand viewing via mewatch.

This year's launch programme celebrates the richness and diversity of Malay arts and culture by presenting the Malay language through various Malay cultural art forms.





The launch programme featured music arrangements directed by Duta Bahasa (Language Ambassador), Megat Firdaus and was hosted by Duta Bahasa, Hans Hamid, and TV personality, Lydia Asyiqin.

The dynamic programme line-up included various performances by local talents and student groups, showcasing the vibrancy of Malay arts. The programme featured poetry recitations by Cultural Medallion recipient, Mr Almahdi Al-Haj Ibrahim – better known by his stage name Nadiputra and *Teman Warisan* (Cultural Heritage Ambassador), Ms Anis Qurratu'aini. The audience and viewers were treated to performances by young talents Izzan Adlan and Nurjannah, as well as a rousing performance by Duta Bahasa Aqmal N. Their performances were accompanied by dancers from Sri Warisan. The launch programme also featured a *wayang kulit* segment by Sri Setia Pulau Singa to introduce the newly appointed Duta Bahasa (Language Ambassador), Mr Hidayat Nordin, Ms Izyan Mellyna and Mr Fatih Hamdani. Students from Temasek Polytechnic Fusion Percussion and ITE College Central Ardwinda also livened up the launch programme with their energetic percussion and *dikir barat* fperformances.

This year's launch programme also showcased the profiles of a young budding writer, Fadhli Fadzil and a *bangsawan* practitioner, Syazza Stoffa, representing the next generation of youths committed to preserving and promoting the Malay language.

The launch programme also featured our Rakan Bahasa (Friends of the Language) participants in engaging interviews focused on the Malay language.
