## BULAN BAHASA 2018 DEBUTS COMMEMORATIVE VIDEO CELEBRATING A 30 YEAR MILESTONE

**1 September 2018** – Celebrating 30 years since the first edition of *Bulan Bahasa* was held by *Majlis Bahasa Melayu Singapura* (MBMS or the Malay Language Council, Singapore) in 1988, *Bulan Bahasa* 2018 (Malay Language Month) was officially launched this afternoon.

Minister for Education, Mr Ong Ye Kung, was Guest of Honour at today's launch, held at Wisma Geylang Serai (WGS). *Bulan Bahasa* will run for two months, from 18 August to 14 October 2018. The variety of programmes, events and activities, presented by community partners, will showcase the versatility of the Malay language, as they continue to be anchored by the themes of *Bulan Bahasa – Ilmu* (Knowledge), *Budaya* (Culture) and *Mesra* (Relationships).

A commemorative video documenting Bulan Bahasa's 30-year journey was also presented today. It encapsulates the contributions of leaders and community towards the development of the Malay language in Singapore, and features many anecdotes from the Malay Language Council, Singapore and the Bulan Bahasa Committee, past and present.

## **A Day of Celebrations**

As the new Malay social, cultural and heritage hub, Wisma Geylang Serai (WGS) sets a fitting backdrop for the launch, reinforcing Geylang Serai's role as a social centre for the Malay community in Singapore.

Visitors to WGS were engaged in an array of exciting activities and performances presented by partners, schools, *Duta Bahasa* and *Rakan Bahasa*, encouraging them to appreciate the Malay language and culture.

At the launch ceremony, Mdm Rahayu Mahzam, Chairman of the Bulan Bahasa Committee, expressed her gratitude for the opportunity to continue the legacy built by the community and past chairpersons of the *Bulan Bahasa* Committee. She also emphasised the effort and dedication put in by various *Duta Bahasa* to make *Bulan Bahasa* celebrations special this year.

"Many *Duta Bahasa* have been actively involved in the planning of the launch celebrations today," says Mdm Rahayu. "This reflects the passion of our *Duta Bahasa* in making the language come alive and our confidence that it would continue to remain relevant."



"My hope is for the community to be inspired by such efforts, and I encourage everyone to take up the baton in promoting the use of the Malay language. Ensuring the continued use of the language is a concerted effort, and I call upon everyone in the community, especially parents to spend more time with the children, to use the Malay language at home. We have to instill pride and confidence in our young, when they use the language," adds Mdm Rahayu.

On behalf of the Bulan Bahasa Committee, Mdm Rahayu Mahzam has also expressed a commitment to encourage partners to present language appreciation programmes and opportunities, beyond Bulan Bahasa, and also to seeking out new partners to bring into the Bulan Bahasa fold, as this would ensure continuity of its mission and efforts.

#### Gerak Tari Bulan Bahasa - A Dance Tutorial Video
