OFFICIAL LAUNCH OF BULAN BAHASA @ TAMPINES 2014

For the first time ever, this year's Bulan Bahasa would be extended to the housing estates in Tampines. Come Saturday evening, 13 September 2014, residents will be entertained by popular celebrities and poets such as R. Ismail, Elfie Ismail, EISS, Orkestra Sri Temasek, Aisyah Salim, Basir Suparti and Saffri M. Manaf at the Launch of the Bulan Bahasa @ Tampines 2014 held at the Tampines West Community Club.

- Mr Heng Swee Keat, Minister for Education and Adviser to Tampines Grassroots Organisations will be the Guest-of-Honour for this event. He will be accompanied by Advisers to Tampines Grassroots Organisations, Mr Masagos Zulkifli, Mr Mah Bow Tan, Ms Irene Ng and Mr Baey Yam Keng. The Launch will held in a musical concert setting, whereby Mr Heng will launch the event by conducting an 30-strong orchestra ensemble. Following that, in accordance to Malay tradition, he will cut a giant cake of "Pulut Kunyit", or glutinous rice which signifies good fortune and wealth.
